

HOLIDAY MULL PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Photos must be of (or taken from) Mull or Iona or the local small islands (e.g. Staffa) and surrounding sea.
2. Entries must be received by 31st December 2011.
3. A maximum of five images per entrant
4. Entries to be submitted by emailing JPEG photos to Holiday Mull: photocomp@holidaymull.co.uk.
5. Size of image not to exceed 3264x2448 pixels, nor 6MB, please.
6. This year we are particularly looking for panoramic images, suitable for the web page banner (aspect ratio about 4:1). These images are displayed at 933x248px, but your entry need not conform to those dimensions.
7. The competition is open to residents and visitors to the Isles of Mull and Iona. Photographs must be taken within the calendar years 2010-11.
8. The Competition is Open to adults aged 16 or over, and to children with the consent of a parent or guardian.
9. The winners will be selected within 90 days of the closing date and will be notified as soon as possible thereafter. The winner is required to contact Holiday Mull to confirm acceptance of their prize within 14 days of notification. In the event of non-acceptance within the specified period, or if the person is not contactable, Holiday Mull reserves the right to reallocate the prize awarded to the next selected valid entry.
10. By entering the competition, entrants grant Holiday Mull the right to use their photograph(s) for promotional purposes, including but not limited to perpetual use on Holiday Mull websites, brochures, catalogues or any other printed Material. Entries may also be displayed on the Holiday Mull web sites and Flickr group.
11. The first prize consists of: a Photography Workshop on the Isle of Mull with Phil McDermott resident professional. The prizes are non-transferable. A winner unable to take up this option may choose an electronic copy of an image from Phil MacDermott's gallery (subject to agreement with Phil MacDermott). A cash alternative may be paid at the discretion of the judges. Second Prize £100, Third Prize £50.
12. If there is an insufficient number of entries, or if in the opinion of the judges, the entries are of insufficiently high quality, entries may be carried over to 2012.
13. It is a condition of entry that the terms and conditions of the competition are accepted as final and that entrants agree to abide by the rules. No correspondence will be entered into.
14. Holiday Mull will not accept responsibility for loss of entries through technical fault, transmission delays or incomplete, illegible or other damaged entries. Proof of entry is not automatically proof of receipt.
15. In the event of unforeseen circumstances Holiday Mull reserves the right to offer

alternative prizes.
